On Wednesday evenings beginning at 6:30 p.m., the First Kids will be exploring the amazing miracles of Jesus in the "Science of Jesus".


Don't forget to join us for a meal each Wednesday starting at 5:30 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall. We will have some kid friendly options as well!

March will be an exciting time in the musical life of the church as we wrap up Lent and celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday, March 31. Coming up on March 17, Kiril Laskarov, the Principal Violinist and Concertmaster of the Arkansas Symphony, along with ASO cellist, Daniel Kline will be playing in worship. They will be accompanying the Chancel Choir on a beautiful arrangement of Charles Wesley's Lenten hymn "Jesus Lover of My Soul", along with Linda Kennedy on piano. Linda and Kiril will be playing "Meditation on Thais" for the prelude that day, and Kiril and Daniel will be playing a duet for the musical meditation. Please plan to attend traditional worship that day, either in person or online. During Holy Week, there will be beautiful anthems on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday that the choir has been preparing.
